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Meeting of the Tyler Mountain Volunteer Fire Department Board of Directors SPECIAL Meeting Minutes

## **Old Business**

The purpose of this special meeting is to review budget items before the next official board meeting.

## **New Business**

Jaden Long advised he had revised the budget, he's not sure what happened to some line items that were in the old budgets.

Some items were taken off the new budget. Back flow testing was questioned, they said we've never done that, it was removed.

Portable equipment rental for \$1200 was removed.

Small equipment & tools were removed - \$500.

Radio repair & maintenance was removed - \$250.

Oil dry is supplied by Napa in Nitro, so we didn't buy it, and was removed from the budget - \$100.

It was determined that postage for the mailings will be \$2500 and folding and stuffing will be \$800 for both mailings.

The gas monitors & calibration for \$12,000 was offset with a grant.

Jaden ran income numbers for the last couple of years; income has gone down every year.

The department will need to purchase a new truck in the next 2-3 years. We will need to do more fundraising.

Looking at a dry rescue truck from Dunbar, that would have everything needed. It will be able to access most parts of our area. We want to sell the new truck that the last administration purchased. They said they may have someone that may be interested in purchasing the old tanker for \$9000.

Tim made a motion to purchase the rescue from Dunbar, seconded by Vickie, the motion carried and was unanimously approved. In purchasing this truck, we need to make an effort to sell the new 231, to be able to get rid of that payment, all agreed.

Greg made a motion to sell utility 238 to Chris for \$3000, Jeff seconded the motion, approved by 5 with Chris abstaining, the motion carried.

Firefighters think doing a go fund me is a bad idea, they would like to do something else for fundraising.

We got about \$1000 from Mardi Gras on 4/27/2025.

A motion was made by Tim and seconded by Greg that the meeting be adjourned at 8:05pm. The motion was unanimously approved.
