## **Call to Order Meeting**

At 7:07pm Chris called the meeting to order.

## **Old Business**

The previous meeting minutes were reviewed, a motion was made by Vickie and second by Chris, motion carried, and the motion was approved.

## **New Business**

Greg reviewed the financial statements, the balance sheet and the profit and loss statement.

The fire alarm has been installed in the community building.

E236-The shoot on the back has been fixed and paid for.

The invoice to the grant writer has been paid.

Delayed in printing out the annual dues letters for both residential and businesses because the printing company is behind due to the upcoming Primary Elections. As soon as they are available, they will be sent out.

The hot water tank had to be replaced in the community building.

Chipper gave us receipts for the chargers he bought and needs to be reimbursed.

E234 Needs a connector, wiring harness, gaskets, container clips and some other parts. Additional charges will apply.

E231 will go to Milton, to replace a valve as soon as E234 is back fixed.

Chipper said that he and the officers are updating some rules and regulations and will be bringing the changes to the board meeting next month.

Chipper stated that a committee needs to be put together to review the bylaws and vote on updating them in September.

Chipper had the cascade machine looked at and it has been tested.

Chris Lacey passed his FF2 test.

Chipper has received a few estimates on fixing the sinking concrete outside of the bay doors. Dry Works hasn't gotten back to him yet, but it will come with a warranty.

The second estimate is from Alford's that would use a limestone slurry, with a projected cost of \$49,000.

The third estimate is Marco Concrete would be approximately 10 to \$12,000 but they do not guarantee the lift or provide a warranty.

CW Sigmon would need a letter to present to the county commission with estimates to see if any grant funds would be available.

Chipper wants to change the open house to June 13<sup>th</sup> due to a scheduling conflict. We are all in agreement with him if the day is available.

Tim said that the Egg Your House event brought in \$275 minus expenses.

Chipper made a motion and Chris seconded that the meeting be adjourned at 7:45p.m. The motion was unanimously approved.
